Westminster Schools of Augusta Statement of Faith

I BELIEVE in one sovereign and triune God, eternally existing in three persons: the everlasting Father, His only begotten Son, Jesus Christ our Lord, and the Holy Spirit, the Lord and Giver of Life, who, proceeds from the Father and the Son; and I believe that God created the heavens and the earth out of nothing by His spoken word, and for His own glory.

I BELIEVE that God has revealed Himself and His truth in the created order, in the Scripture, and supremely in Jesus Christ; and that the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments are verbally inspired by God and inerrant in the original writing, so that they are fully trustworthy and of supreme and final authority in all they say.
